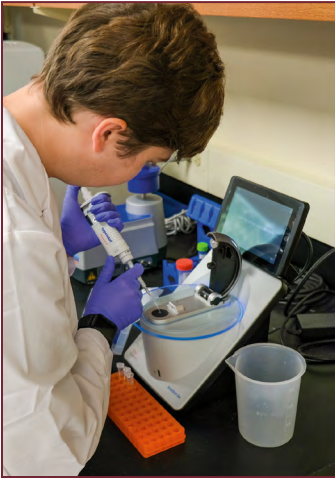

Maximizing Human Potential

PHILANTHROPIC INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITIES

Anne's College prioritizes student support, building upon the most generous education scholarship program in Florida and awarding more than \$1.2 million in the fall of 2026. Additional investment is critical for the college to elevate student success and increase faculty impact.

The dean's fundraising priorities include:

- ⇒ Creating 30 Master Teacher Scholarships to better prepare students in the five-year BS/MS program. 30 new scholarships will allow Anne's College to support 100% of BS/MS students.
- ⇒ Establishing 24 new doctoral fellowships to attract the best and brightest students and double the current fellowship pool, or 60% of all incoming Ph.Ds.
- ⇒ Building departmental endowments for improved culture and innovation through space naming opportunities in Stone, Sandels, William Johnston and the Institute for Sport Sciences and Medicine.
- ⇒ Supporting pathways to FSU Health through new scholarships and program endowment for FSU's best undergraduate pre-med programs.
