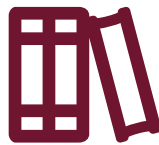
The libraries' collections include over 5.4 million volumes, with a website offering access to more than 446 databases, over 319,000 electronic journals and 2.8 million e-books.

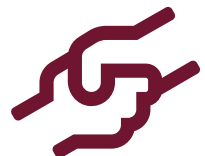
